

Fifth Grade Supply List

Hi Parents, Students, and Everyone,

Hope everyone is enjoying their summer. Time is moving so quickly and soon, we will be preparing to start school once again. This is the supply list that your child will need for the beginning of school.

- 12-#2 pencils, sharpened, prefer not the mechanical pencils
- Eraser—the white polymer erasers work the best, but the pink is okay
- Blue or black erasable pens, *Please not the ones that click in & out*
- Color markers, fine or bold,
- Color pencils, we use these a lot
- One dry erase marker any color
- One highlighter any color
- One black sharpie
- Age appropriate scissors, not preschool safety type scissors,
- Pencil box to hold the above items,
- 5 composition books, (prefer these over spiral, paper pulls out too easily)
- 12” ruler with inches and metric measurements,
- 5 book covers,
- Glue sticks,(send one now, save the rest for when they use up the first)
- Bottle of school glue
- A clip board
- One sturdy pocket folder for transporting papers to and from school,
- A plastic milk crate type box to put everything in next to their desk

Items that will be collected and used in the classroom throughout the year:

- 1 box of large zip lock baggies, 1 box of lunch size zip lock baggies (preferably not the \$ store brand, they rip as they come out of the box)
- Container of sanitizing wipes, – preferably Lysol to kill germs
- Bottle of hand sanitizer,
- A box of tissues, I find Puff’s with lotion work best on sore noses.

I am sure I have left something important off this list, but the above list will get the students off to a good start to 5th grade. Thank you for everything and will be seeing every one soon.
